KAYSON'S STORY

Kayson's journey with Kawasaki Disease began with what seemed like common baby ailments—red eyes, a persistent rash, and unexplained fevers—each time dismissed as "normal." Over the course of weeks, his symptoms worsened, and despite multiple doctor visits and five misdiagnoses, no one saw the real danger unfolding.

It wasn't until his little hand turned blue that the urgency became clear. After countless tests, sleepless nights, and overwhelming fear, we finally had an answer—Kawasaki Disease with a giant coronary artery aneurysm.

The road to recovery included seven days in the PICU, IV treatments, blood thinners, and a team of incredible doctors who saved his life.

Today, Kayson is thriving, but our fight for awareness isn't over.

Trust your instincts, advocate for your child, and never settle for "this is normal." Kawasaki Disease is rare but real, and early diagnosis can change everything.
